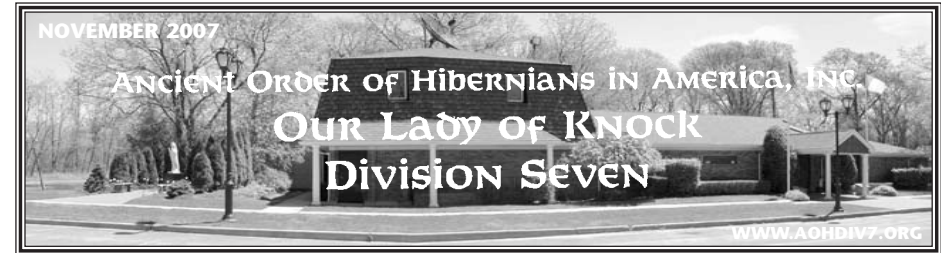

Success Story

Congratulations to the Carnegie-Mellon Pipe Band for their 3rd place finish at the Anne Arundel Highland Games in Baltimore County on October 13. Roisin Dubh's own Mike Masiar participated in the piping contingent under the direction of Pipe Major Alasdair Gillies.

Mike began his piping career at the age of 13 on a Thursday night at the usual meeting of the Roisin Dubh Irish Pipe Band held weekly at the AOH Division 7 Hall in East Islip. Under the watchful mentorship of many members of the band Mike quickly learned the difficult art of highland piping. His initial interest can be attributed to the influences of his late grandfather, Francis George McCarthy. Grandpa eagerly invited

the family to Irish festivals and competitions over the years including the annual Feis at St Joseph's in Brentwood, and regular visits to East Durham and Hunter Mountain. Mike won first place in several solo competitions in junior grade 4 including the AOH Feis' in Rockland and also in Nassau County.

Now a senior at the University of Pittsburgh, Mike continued his interest in piping while in Pittsburgh. He auditioned and was invited to join the band at Carnegie-Mellon University by the world famous Alasdair Gillies. Pipe major Gillies has been an instructor in the school of Music at Carnegie-Mellon since 1997. Recognized as one of the finest pipers in the world he served as Pipe Major in the Highlanders regiment in Scotland prior to coming to the USA.

Mike is planning on applying to graduate school after finishing his major in Physics at the University of Pittsburgh. He was a grateful recipient of the AOH Div 7, Our Lady of Knock scholarship in 2004.
