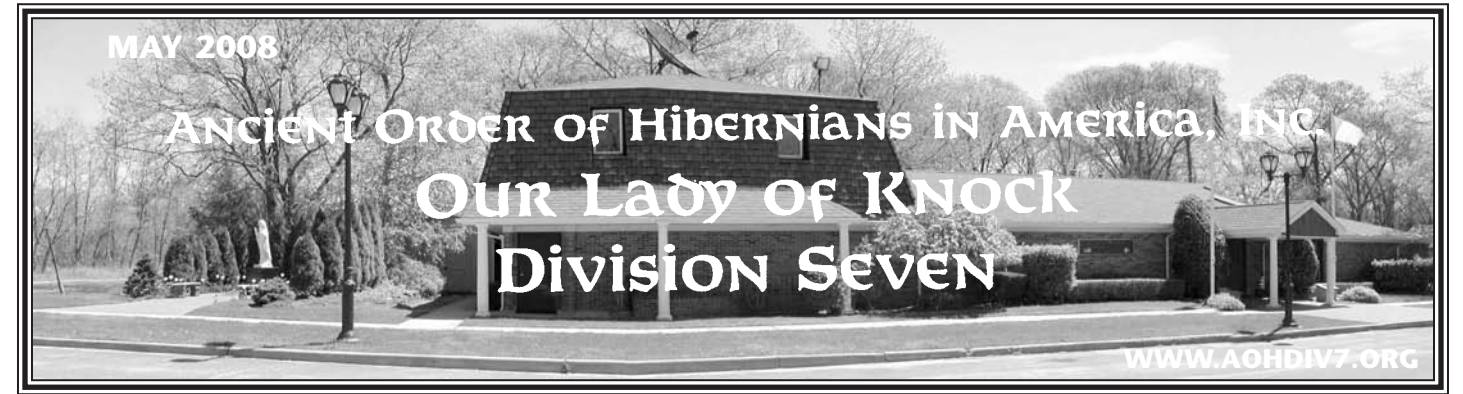

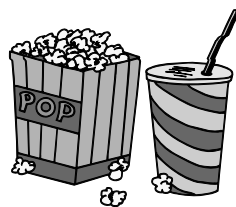

This is one of the few movies that you can say "great for the whole family" and mean it.

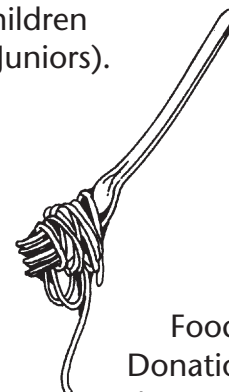
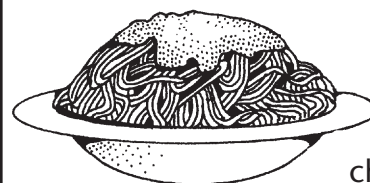
