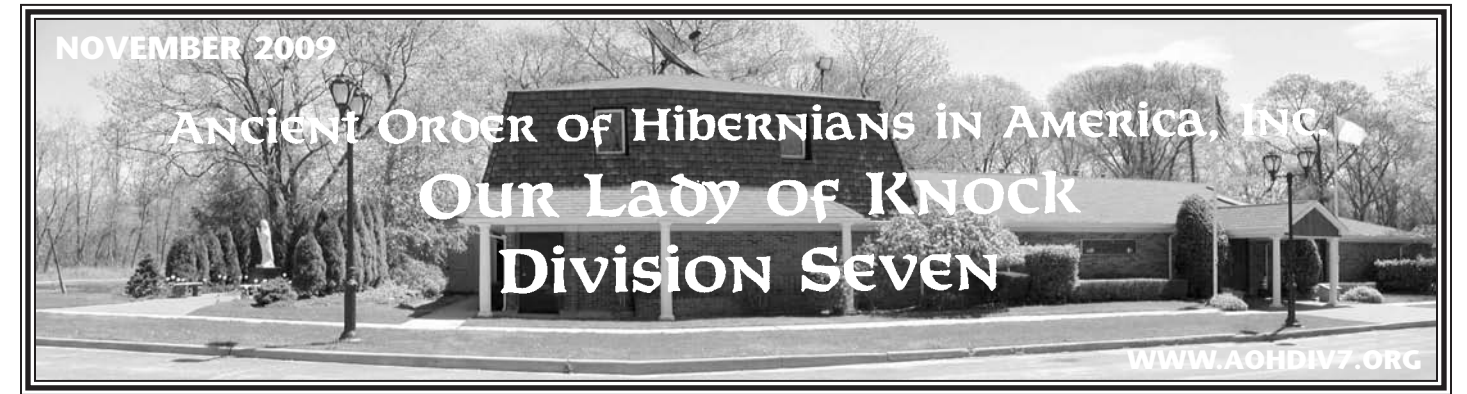

## Right to Life Announcement

On Friday, October 9, 2009 President Barack Obama was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. 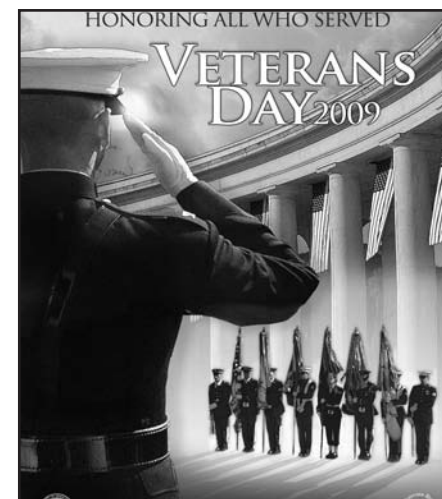

**Open House  
 In Honor of  
 Veterans Day**



Delta Company of The Fighting 69th will be hosting an open house for the public in honor of Veterans Day and to thank the public for its support of the Regiment while it was in combat.

The nickname "Fighting Sixth Ninth" was given to the unit by General Robert E. Lee, Commander, Army of Northern Virginia, CSA at Fredericksburg, Va. About 300 of the unit's soldiers returned from

Afghanistan in January 2009 after a year long tour training the Afghan Army.

In 2005, the 69th was ordered to secure Route Irish, a key route between Baghdad International Airport and "the Green Zone" where the emerging Iraqi government was operating. Route Irish had already developed a reputation as "the most dangerous road in Baghdad" and its security had both military and political implications.

The Regiments vehicles, weapons and equipment will be on display, as well as other current United States Army displays.

The Regiment can trace its history going back as far as the American Revolution and re-enactors have been invited from the Revolution, Civil War and the WWI.

Soldiers who served in Iraq and Afghanistan will also be on hand. Date: Sunday 15 November 2009 Time: 11: 00 AM - 3:00 P.M. Location: 69th Armory 70 Brentwood Road, Bayshore, New York.

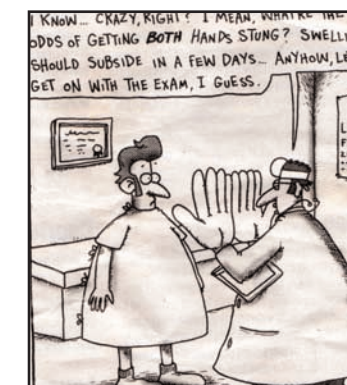
