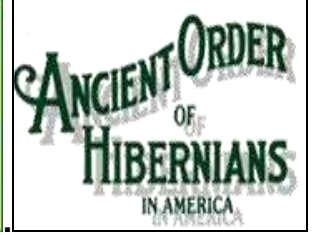


Our Lady of Knock - Division 7, East Islip, NY September/October 2019

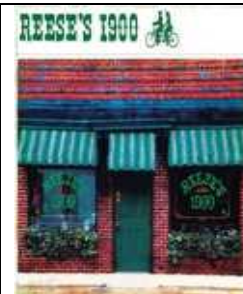
